She succeeded her husband, Néstor Kirchner, who had served as president from 2003 to 2007. The Presidency of Cristina Fernández de Kirchner began on December 10, 2007, when she became President of Argentina. She was an Argentine Senator for the Buenos Aires Province at the time of her victory in the 2007 Presidential election.
