The Z3 M Roadster was introduced in 1996 as the high performance version of the BMW Z3. Cosmetic differences between the Z3 M and the standard Z3 models included front and rear bumpers, gills, boot and mirrors. The standard Z3 models received a facelift in 1999, however the appearance of the Z3 M was not changed.. In the 5 years from 1998 to 2002, approximately 15,000 M Roadsters were produced. The BMW E85/E86 is the first generation of BMW Z4 roadsters and coupés, which were produced from 2002 to 2008. The E85/E86 replaced the Z3 and is the third model in the BMW Z Series. Initial models were in the roadster (E85) body style, with the coupé (E86) body style being added in 2006. As per the Z3, the Z4 was manufactured solely in Greer, South Carolina. New for 2017.
